THERE ARE WATER HOLES WHICH I'M SURE THE DOGS WILL WANT TO TEST OUT SO IT WOULD PAY TO BRING TOWELS TO DRY THEM OFF AFTERWARDS.

AFTER PREVIOUS WALKS IN THE MARAMARUA FOREST WE HAVE ENJOYED COFFEE AND REFRESHMENTS AT THE PUKEKO'S NEST CAFE. THIS IS STILL REACHABLE FROM THIS WALK.
